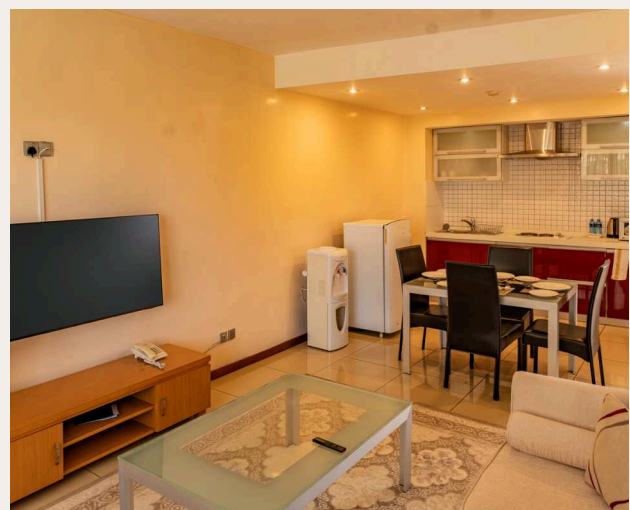
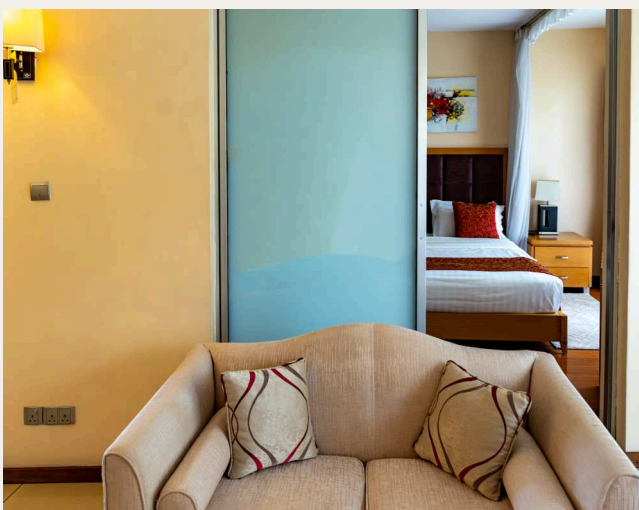

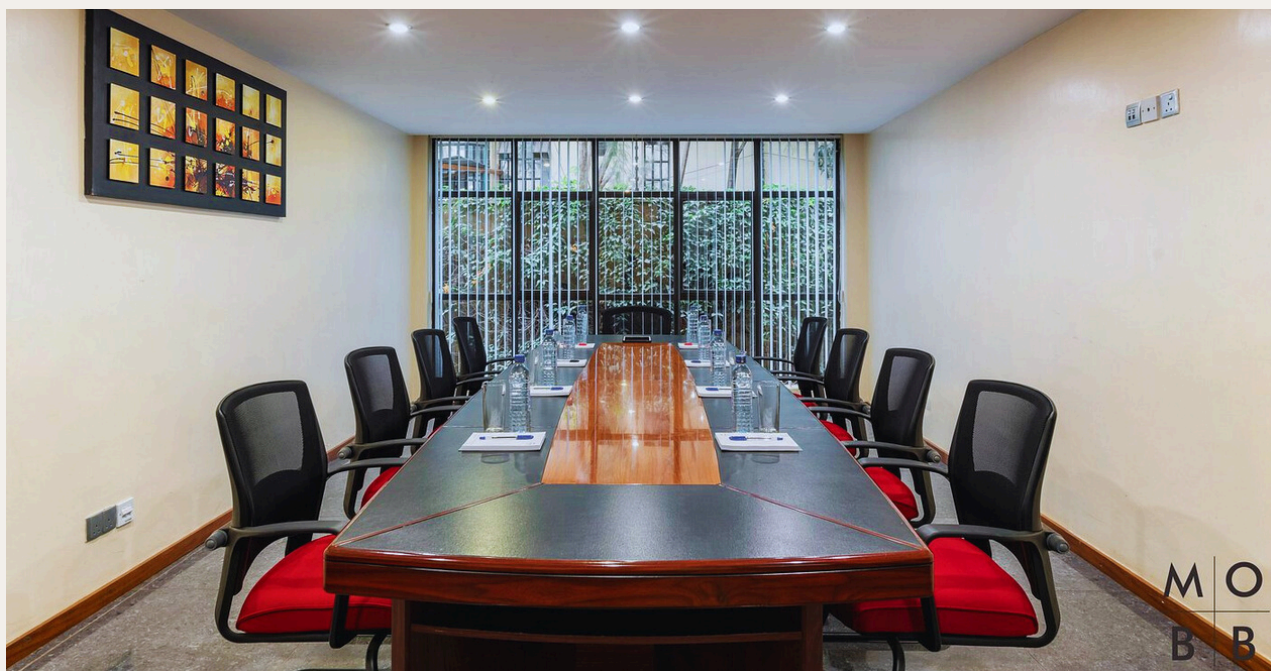
## **Furnished One & Two Bedroom Units**

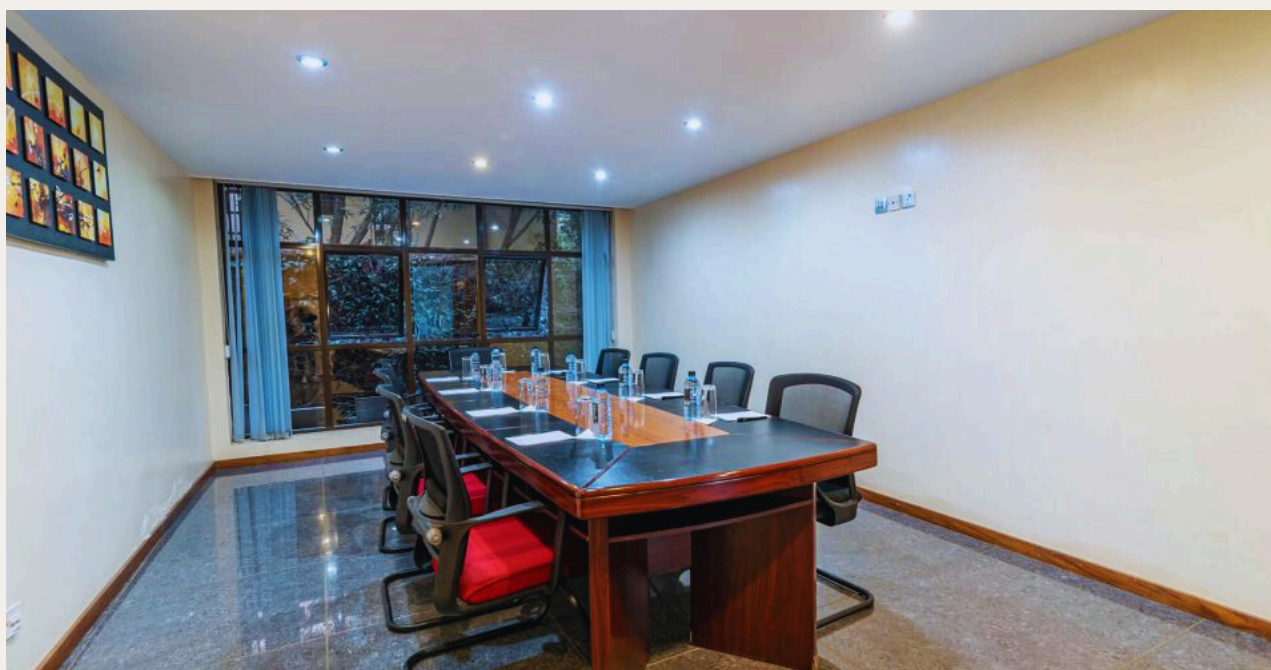

# A Fully Equipped Gym

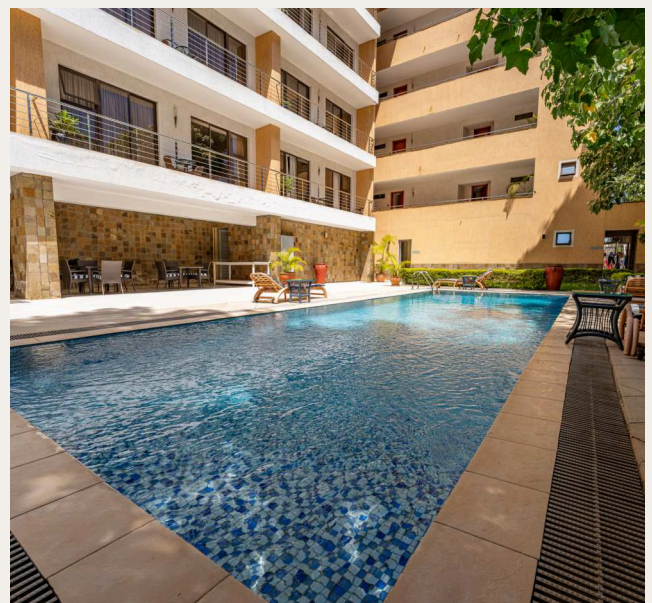


Work out in our fully equipped gymnasium fitted with multipurpose work out equipment, treadmill, elliptical machine, stability ball and different dumbbells and weights.

## **Karen Blixen Museum**

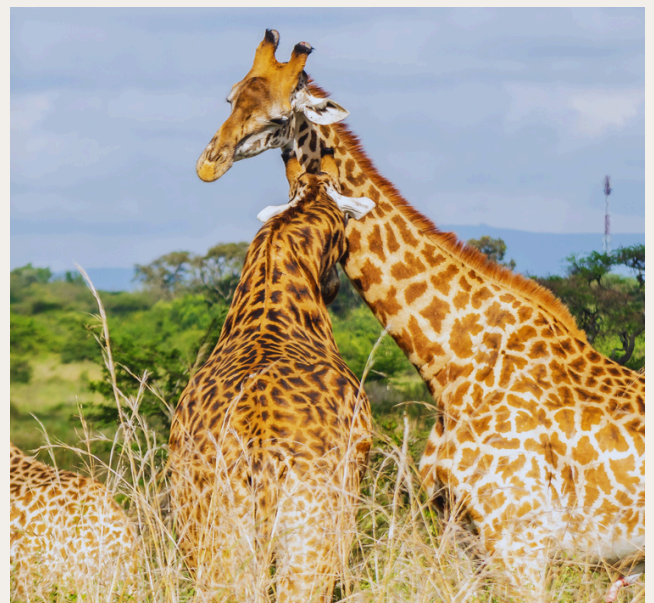
Karen Blixen Museum is a national museum situated about 19KM from Nairobi City centre. It was built in 1912, and was home to the Danish author of 'Out of Africa', Karen Blixen. During your stay, take some few hours of your time and visit Karen Blixen Museum. If you are a lover of history, then this is the place for you. You can pick up a copy of the famous film at the museum shop or browse for handicrafts, posters and postcards, books and other Kenyan souvenirs.



# Nairobi National Park

Wide open grass plains and backdrop of the city scrapers, scattered acacia bush play host to a wide variety of wildlife including the endangered black rhino, lions, leopards, cheetahs, hyenas, buffaloes, giraffes and diverse birdlife with over 400 species recorded. Visitors can enjoy the park's picnic sites, three campsites and the walking trails for hikers.

# Giraffe Center

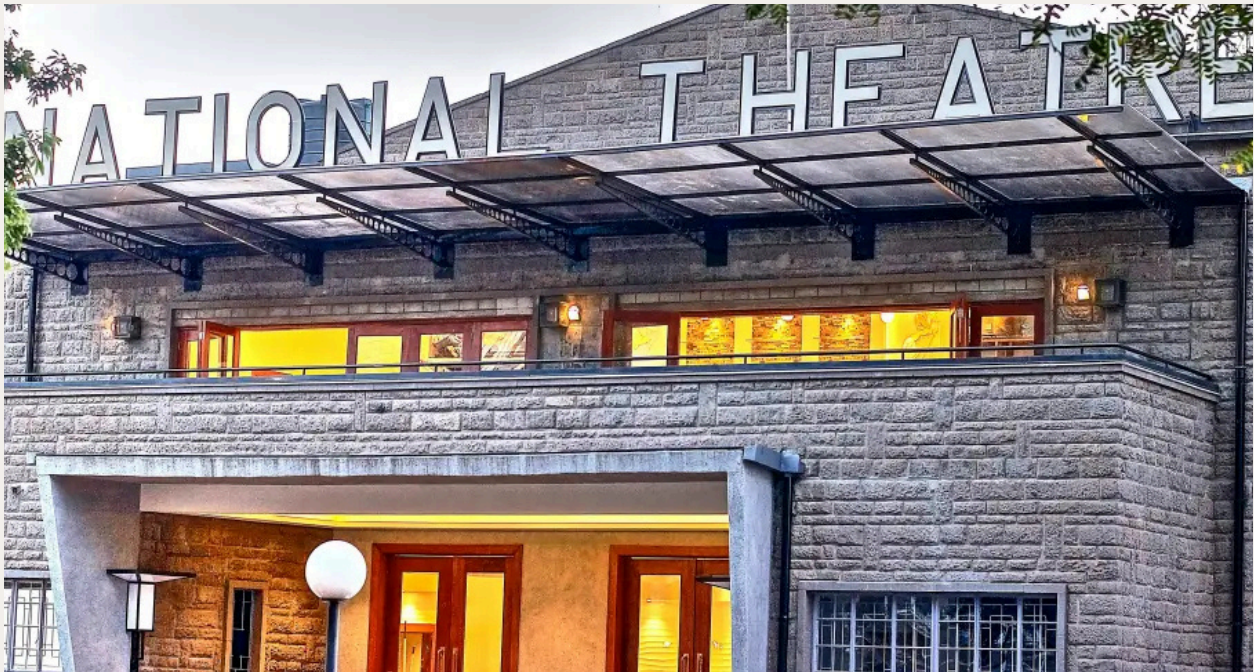
During your stay, take some few hours of your time and visit the Giraffe Center to know about the center and its world-famous inhabitants.



# Kenya National Theatre

The Kenya National Theatre (KNT) is the largest proscenium theatre space in Kenya. It is a government agency under the ministry of state for National Heritage and Culture in Kenya.

KNT offers space for diverse rehearsal, production and staging of drama, live musical concerts, plays and dance, to both local and international clientele.



# John Michuki Memorial Park

Hon. Michuki Memorial Conservation Park, formerly known as Mazingira Park, was established in 2008 to create a public recreation area at an area that was previously a dumpsite and a criminal hideout. It is situated along the Nairobi River between the Globe Roundabout and the Museum Hill interchange.

It is a few metres away from our facility, and it is one of the many green spaces and recreational areas that our guests can enjoy within the city.



# National Museum (and Snake Park)

Located on Museum Hill, the museum showcases Kenya's rich Heritage with four distinct themes representing Kenya's Culture, Nature, History, and Contemporary Art.

Other attractions within the compound include the Snake Park and Botanical Gardens as well as a State of the Art Auditorium that occasionally hosts concerts, film shows, and other events.

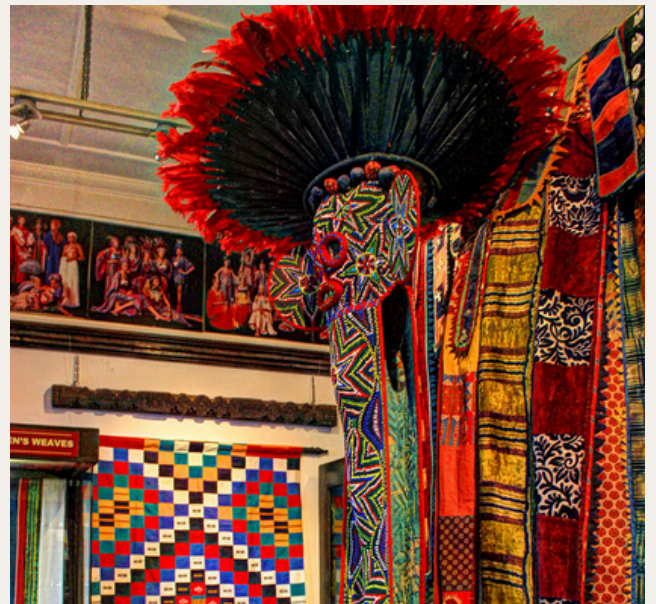
The racecourse was opened 1954, and is nowadays the only racecourse in Kenyan. The first horse racing event in Kenya took place in 1904 in Machakos with Somali ponies.



# Nairobi art gallery

The Nairobi Gallery is located at Kenyatta Avenue and Uhuru Highway roundabout next to Nyayo house.

It was handed over to the National Museums of Kenya for preservation purposes in 1977. It opened its doors to the public in November 2005 when it hosted its first temporary exhibition “Dreaming in Pictures” by JakKatarikawe. Today the Gallery has become the home of Joseph and Sheila Murumbi’s collections. Joseph Murumbi was Kenya’s second vice president. Nairobi Gallery is also dedicated to promoting local artists through displaying of their artwork.



# Karura Forest

Karura Forest is a forest reserve located on the outskirts of the capital, Nairobi.

A lovely little surprise in the middle of the city, Karura Forest is a gem of Nairobi. With over 50 kilometers of walking, biking, and nature trails, this is one of the best places to visit for a taste of nature while still staying in the city.
